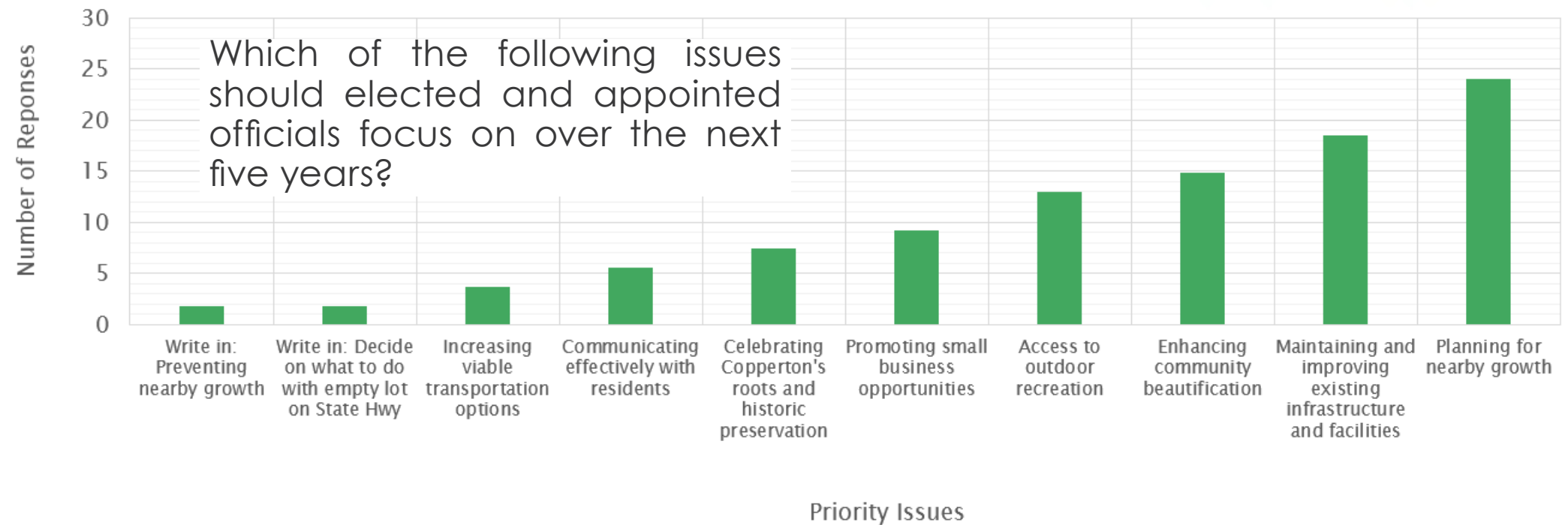


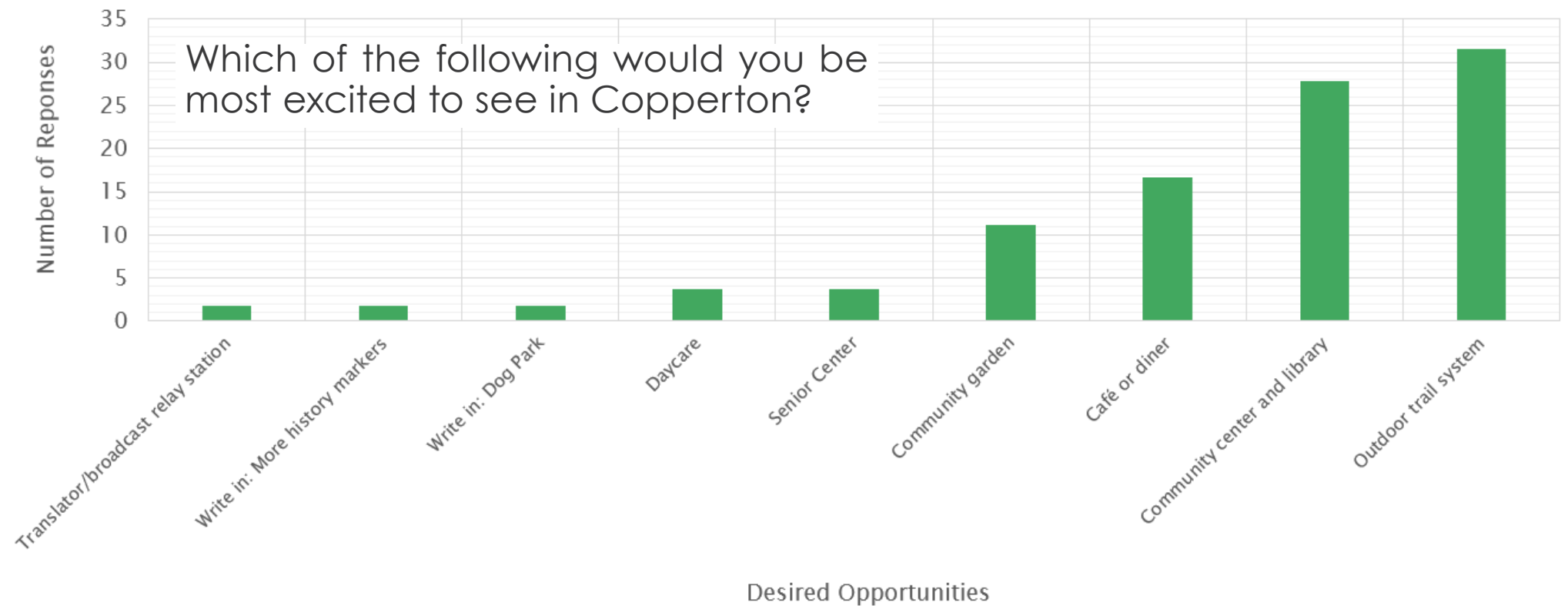
COPPERTON METRO TOWNSHIP AMENITIES AND PRIORITIES SURVEY



To gain widespread public feedback for Copperton's 2020 General Plan, planning staff created the Amenities and Priorities Survey. A postcard with details on accessing the online survey was mailed to every Copperton household. Between June 23rd and July 27th, 54 Copperton residents shared their perspectives. Check out the results:



When requested to: "select which transportation options, if available, you would use at least monthly," 13.6 percent of respondents chose "weekday morning and evening rush-hour shuttle to the Trax Station on 5600 W and Old Bingham Highway." Most respondents, 71.2 percent, selected "none."

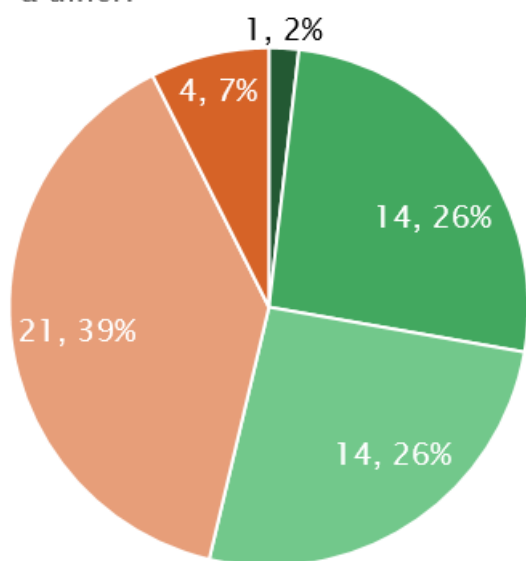


If it became established in Copperton, how often would you use:

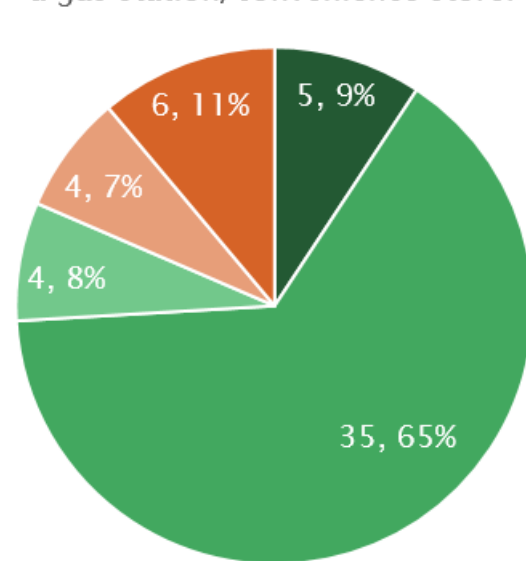
Key: Number of Responses, Percentage of Total Responses

■ Daily ■ Weekly ■ Every other week ■ Monthly ■ Never

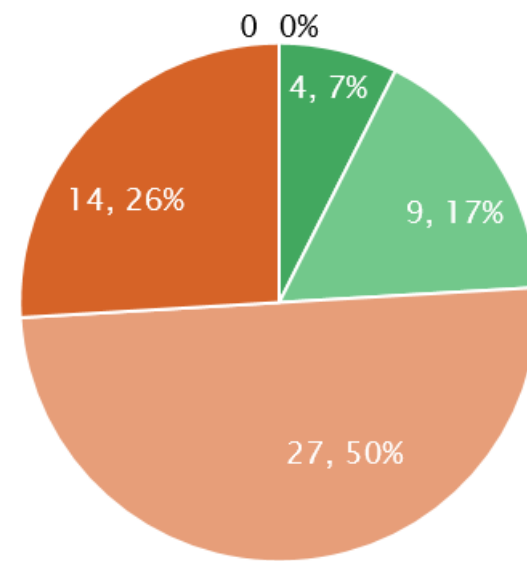

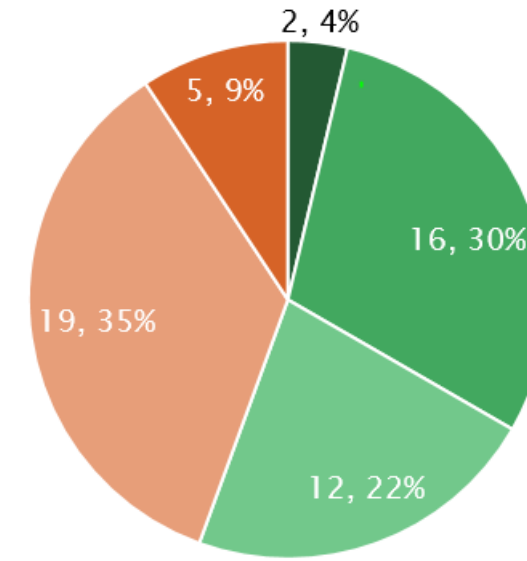

Imagine you left Copperton and came back in 2030. What do you hope to see?

Several themes emerged from responses. The most commonly mentioned themes included: **upkept landscapes and residences** (25 mentions), the **same community** (14), **preserved greenspace** (13), a **small town** (11) with **charming homes** (13) and **historic character** (8), **additional small businesses** (10), and **limited development** (10).

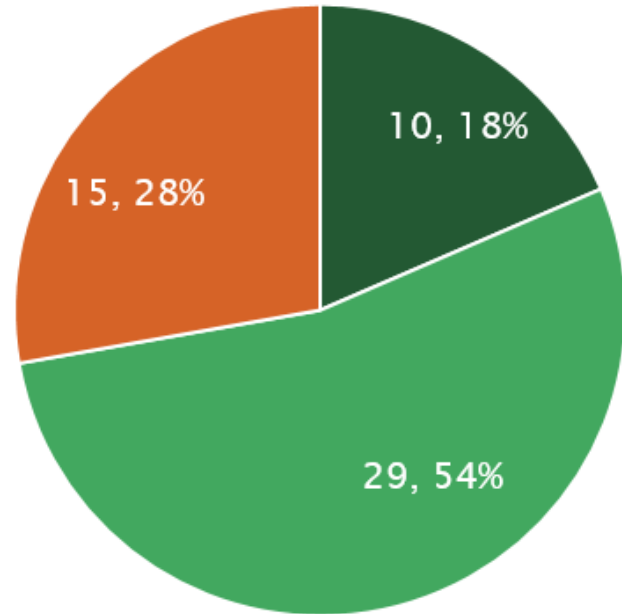


How important are the following infrastructure improvements?

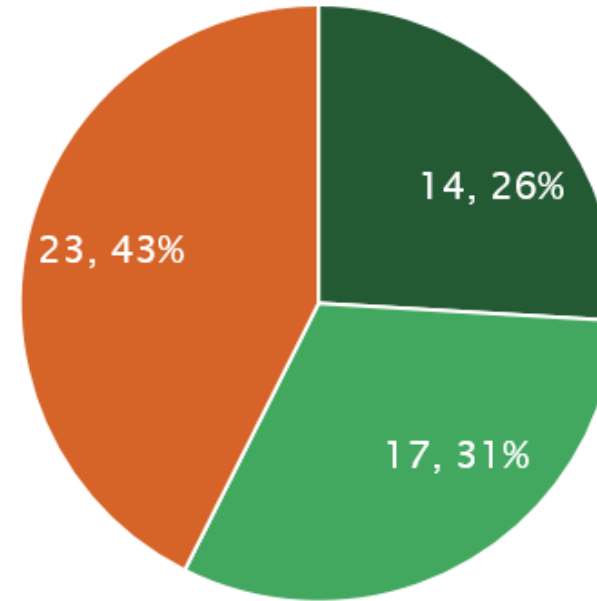
Key: Number of Responses, Percentage of Total Responses

■ Very important ■ Important ■ Not important

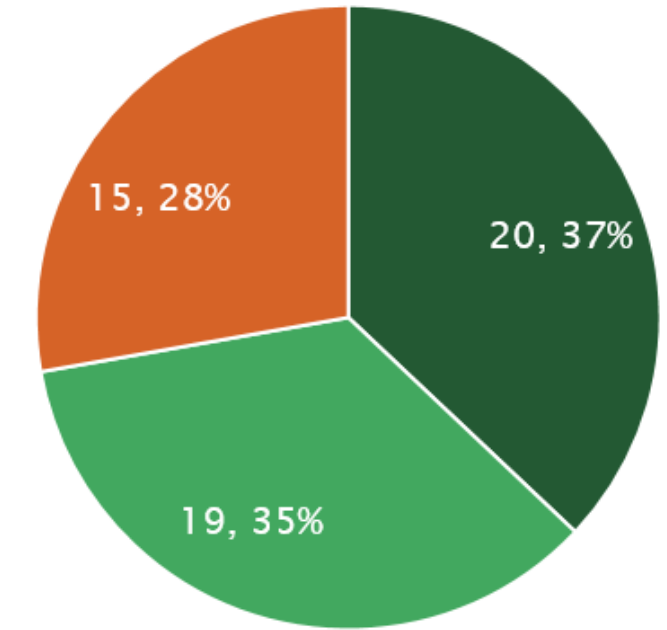
a. Energy efficient lighting (low-pollution, low-cost) on streets adjacent to Copperton Park



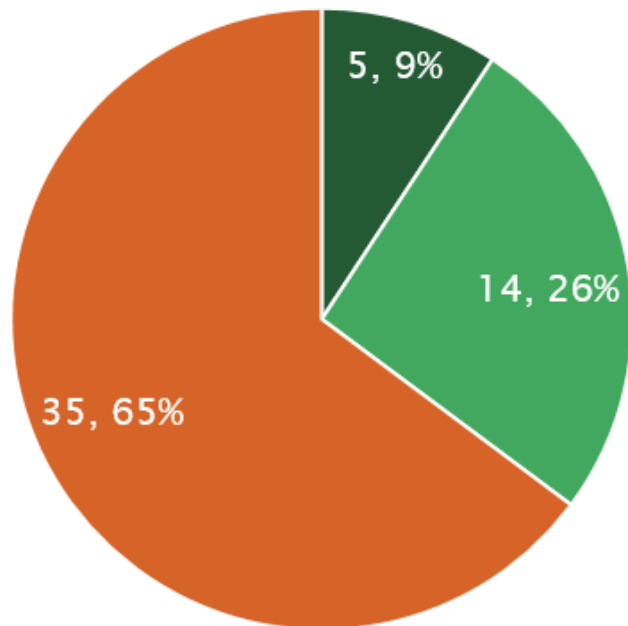
b. Sidewalk and bike infrastructure connecting Copperton to the Trax Station on 5600 W and Old Bingham Highway



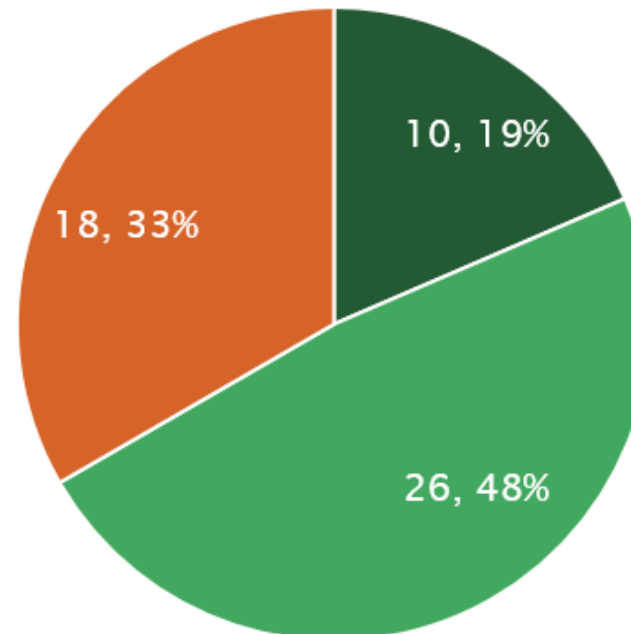
c. Streetscape beautification and improvements along commercial area entering Copperton



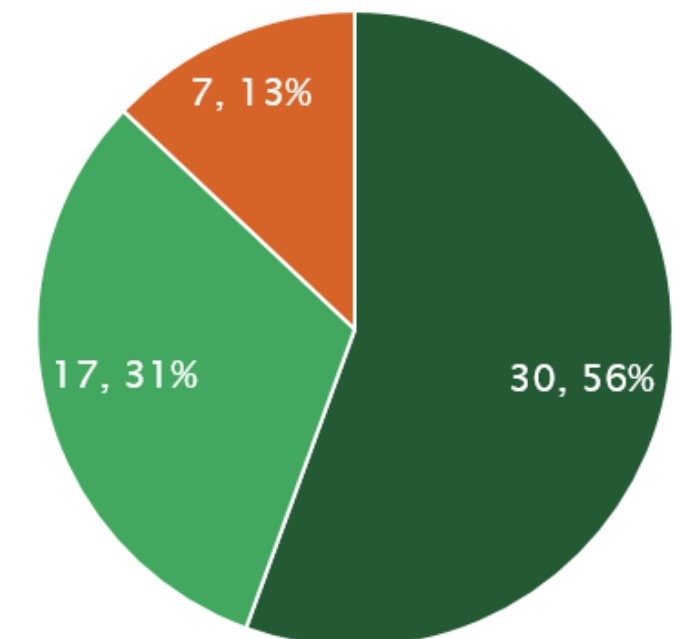
d. Electronic welcome sign at Copperton's entrance that posts community updates

In one phrase or sentence, summarize what you love most about Copperton:

Respondents answered this question very similarly. Residents love that Copperton is a **quiet** (20 mentions), **peaceful** (4), **slow-paced** (3) **small town** (17) with **historic** (6) and **charming** (5) character. They loved Copperton's **relative location** (9) which enables it to retain its small town, rural feel while allowing residents to access big city amenities. Respondents also loved Copperton Park and the surrounding **greenspace** (6). Additionally, respondents love their community! Respondents mentioned the **generous, kind, and close-knit Copperton community** many times (18).

In one phrase or sentence, summarize what you consider Copperton's greatest challenge:

Respondents' stated challenges were also consistent. **Yard and building disrepair** was the most identified challenge (11 mentions). **Neighbor behavior** (10) and **internet behavior** (7) were the second and third most common themes. Other concerns included **encroaching development** (6), **maintaining community character** (5), **a lack of businesses and amenities** (4), **petty crime and nuisances** (4), and **rising expenses** (4).
